



Arrival in Kenya

As part of your volunteer program, Village Volunteers will coordinate for someone meet you at the Jomo Kenyatta airport in Nairobi when your flight arrives. This person will be a resource for you and will transport you to either your volunteer program or to your overnight accommodations in Nairobi depending on what is outlined in your Village Volunteers program itinerary.

Customs Declaration Form

Before landing, you will be asked to complete a form declaring what you are bringing into the country and the estimated value of contents. If you are carrying items for your program such as school supplies, vitamins, or medical supplies for the schools or clinics, please **declare them as gifts**.

Airport Meet Up

When you arrive at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi, you will be greeted by a Village Volunteers representative.

After picking up your luggage, proceed outside and look for the person holding a sign that reads "Village Volunteers." They can assist you in getting acclimated and can help you with exchanging money, checking email, purchasing or renting a cell phone (optional), etc.

Transportation

The person coordinating your airport pick up will coordinate your transportation to your next stop. Depending on the program you're visiting and the time of your arrival flight, you may need to stay overnight in Nairobi on your first night. Village Volunteers will note on your itinerary whether a stay in Nairobi is necessary. If an overnight stay in Nairobi is needed, Village Volunteers will coordinate escorted transportation to your volunteer program the following morning.
